

Megan's Law Form

One of the fundamental responsibilities of Cal Expo is to protect the public. In 1998, the California State Fair implemented a policy requiring that all persons conducting business with, employed by, or volunteering at Cal Expo shall provide the necessary personal information to enable their names to be searched through the Department of Justice's Megan's Law files. This file consists of records of individuals convicted of specified sex offense who are required by Penal Code Section 290 to register as sex offenders.
